Based on the evaluation carried out by National rapid test kit evaluation team, both INSTI test kits are approved for usage in Nigeria and recommended for the following scenarios:

- 1. INSTI HIV-1/HIV-2 antibody rapid test kits have been included as a first-line (screening) test of the national HIV testing algorithm. The INSTI Multiplex HIV-1/2 and Syphilis antibody rapid test kit has been recommended for use for the detection of the syphilis antibody in Nigeria.
- 2. The INSTI Multiplex HIV-1/2 Syphilis Ab Test kit has also been recommended for use among pregnant women, vulnerable risk groups and screening of prospective blood donors for concurrent dual detection of HIV and Syphilis antibodies.
